Privacy Policy

Clinical Hyperbaric ("we," "us," or "our") is committed to protecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard your information when you visit our website or use our services. Please read this policy carefully. If you disagree with its terms, please discontinue use of our site.

1. Information We Collect

We may collect the following types of information:

- **Personal Information**— Your name, email address, phone number, and billing/shipping address, provided voluntarily when you contact us, book a session, or place an order.
- **Device & Technical Information**— IP address, browser type, operating system, and referring URLs collected automatically when you visit our site.
- **Usage Data**— Pages visited, time spent on each page, links clicked, and other behavioral data collected to help us understand how visitors use our site.
- **Payment Information**— Payment card details are processed by secure third-party payment processors. Clinical Hyperbaric does not store, view, or have access to full card numbers or payment credentials.

2. How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect for the following purposes:

- **Order Processing & Fulfillment**— To process equipment purchases, schedule sessions, and coordinate delivery or installation services.
- **Responding to Inquiries**— To reply to questions and messages submitted via phone, email, or contact forms.
- **Updates & Promotions**— To send you information about new products, special offers, or wellness tips. You may opt out of marketing communications at any time by contacting us or using the unsubscribe link in any email.
- **Website Improvement**— To analyze usage patterns and improve the functionality, content, and user experience of our website.
- **Legal Compliance**— To comply with applicable laws, regulations, or legal processes.

3. Data Protection & Security

We implement reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards designed to protect your personal information from unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, and destruction. These measures include encrypted communications (SSL/TLS), restricted staff access to personal data, and secure third-party payment processing.
